





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# "Exponential Insights" Newsletter: We love a good challenge

### Looking ahead to 3rd & 4th quarters 2018

As we have highlighted in our newsletters throughout the first half of 2018, this year could have not gotten off to a better start. We have sold a record number of houses and we have exceeded expectations so far in 2018.

With that being said we do face some challenges as we get into the second half of the year, our primary challenge is getting building permits from the city (L&I). Over the past few years we could submit a request for a building permit to the city and expect to have an approved building permit in 30-45 days. That has not been the case for the past several months. The turnaround time for an approved building permit today is 90+ days.

There are several reasons for the slower turnaround times. One is for corner lots, when we build a property on a corner lot, before we can submit a request for a building permit we need approval from the city streets department. The streets department requires us to do a survey, get civil engineers involved and conform with all Americans with

Disabilities Act (ADA). All of this takes a significant amount of time. We have 15 properties in the corner lot approval process at the moment.

Another new requirement by the city, which is impacting every building permit we are working to obtain (including corner lots) is approval of our plans from the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) that building plans meet city utility requirements. This PWD approval has added at least six weeks to every approval request.

Good news/Bad news is that we are not alone, every developer in the city is in the same boat. Everyone is feeling the same pain trying to get building permits from the city.

I can assure you with 100% certainty that we are doing everything we can to get these permits approved. We follow-up with the city and as well our Architects and Engineers on a daily basis pushing everyone involved to get our permits approved. We appreciate your patience as well.



**Phase Two Description:** After framing is complete the roof deck is weatherproofed. At this point, the house is sealed and rough-in mechanicals (HVAC, Plumbing, Electric and Sprinklers) are installed. Phase two is considered complete after insulation and drywall are installed, along with some additional exterior work.

After this, final steps are to install appliances, a final painting and the house is cleaned. Done!
